## Safety Policies For Innovative Technologies in STEM Summer Camp

- **Before you arrive:** Parents are required to check the temperature of their children to ensure that it is not above 99.4° F before leaving home. Campers with temperatures above 99.4° F should remain at home. If we determine that a camper is sick, we will move that camper to one of our **isolation rooms**. While in isolation, he/she will be able to continue working until picked up. If your child is placed in isolation, you will be called to pick him/her up. We will work with families to provide make-up training if such becomes necessary.
- All public-facing surfaces, including doors, table tops and restrooms, that campers will likely touch as they enter, occupy and exit our training facility will be sanitized twice during camp using commercial grade sanitizer.
- Each camper must use the **Sanitization Station** upon entering the training facility to thoroughly sanitize their hands.
- All campers and staff will be required to **wear masks**. Campers could lower their masks once seated but whenever they need to get up, they must wear them correctly.
- Campers will be **seated 6 feet or more apart** and will not interact with one another at a distance lesser than 6 feet.
- Camp instruction will be delivered in a hands-on fashion where campers will have their own printouts and watch engaging video solutions to guide them in completing their daily activities and challenges. For instructor-led instructions and critical thinking sessions, instructors will remain 6 feet or more apart from students.
- Half of our camp activities/instruction (DRONES) will be done outdoors to create a much safer learning environment.
- Campers will have their own **dedicated space**, **chair**, **computer and other training devices**, **including micro**: **bit**, to use for the duration of camp.
- **Drop Off:** Do not approach the entrance if you see another family dropping of their child/children. Parents are not allowed to go beyond the lobby area and you must leave the lobby area immediately after signing in your child/children. No more than two families should be in the lobby area at once. Parents should look through the plate glass to observe the lobby area before going inside. A folder with your child's name will be available with his/her sign in sheet. Parents who wish to remain can use the parking lot and lawn area at the back of the property.
- Picking Up: When you return for your child/children and you arrive at the front of our parking lot, you will need to text us to let us know that you are outside. We will then escort your child/children outside, 6 feet apart from them. More details about pick up will be provided later.
